26	DISTILLED SPIRITS OR SMOKING CIGARETTES] during pregnancy can cause
27	birth defects. Alcohol use can cause cancer, including breast and colon cancers."
28	The second sign must read, "WARNING: A person who provides alcoholic beverages
29	to a person under 21 years of age, if convicted under AS 04.16.051, could be
30	imprisoned for up to five years and fined up to \$50,000." The third sign must read,
31	"WARNING: An unaccompanied person under 21 years of age who enters these

- premises in violation of law may, under AS 04.16.049(e), be civilly liable for damages of \$1,500." The license or permit holder shall display the first and second signs in a manner that would make them conspicuous to a person who will be purchasing or consuming alcoholic beverages or smoking cigarettes on the licensed or designated premises and shall conspicuously display the third sign at each door through which customers enter the licensed premises.
